



FAUCET USER AND MAINTENANCE MANUAL

FOR CONSIDERATION



01 Read and follow the installation guide steps included with each product.



02 Inspect all the materials upon receipt. Ensure that the faucet comes with all its components. If you find any discrepancies, please note them on the invoice or the transport guide and return the product to the store or the carrier for replacement.



03 Do not install the product if any of the parts are missing. Please keep in mind that any installed fixture is considered accepted by you.



04 All faucets require careful handling during storage and installation to prevent scratches, chipping, breakage of their components, or dents on their surface.



05 To install the faucets, you will need the following items: Shower valver socket wrench, adjustable wrench, pliers, flathead and phillips screwdrivers, pipe wrench.



06 When installing a faucet on the sink or countertop, please be aware that excessive pressure could potentially damage or break the walls of these fixtures. Tighten the various nuts until they are secure, but avoid over-tightening.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE



Clean the faucets with a soft cloth and mild hand soap. Do not use acidic products, those with alcohol, or abrasive particles that could permanently scratch or damage the finish.



Periodically unscrew the aerator located at the tip of the faucet spout and clean the flow restrictor positioned between the shower ball and the spout arm to remove any potential buildup of limescale and/or construction residues that may have accumulated in the plumbing system.



When cleaning wall coverings or the sink, we recommend covering the faucets with a soft cloth to protect the chrome finish from chemical splashes, acids, or abrasives. If you use acids or chemicals to clean the areas, do not close the windows or doors, and allow the spaces to ventilate during and after cleaning for at least 48 hours.



Do not scrub the faucet's surface with aluminum or wire sponges, as they can scratch the chrome finish. Use mild liquid detergents and cotton cloths for daily cleaning. Do not use acetone, varsol, muriatic acid, or any organic solvents, as they can cause serious damage to the finish of your faucet.
